



## **Letter of Guarantee – AmerCareRoyal Products and “Prop 65”**

In 1986, California voters approved an initiative to address their growing concerns about exposure to toxic chemicals. That initiative became the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, better known by its original name of Proposition 65. Proposition 65 requires the State of California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer or birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 800 chemicals since it was first published in 1987. Proposition 65 requires businesses to notify Californians about significant amounts of chemicals in the products they purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment.

All items sold and distributed by AmerCareRoyal (“ACR”), and its operating companies (AmerCare, Royal Paper, PrimeWare, 511 Food Service, and Ocala) comply with “Prop 65”, including recent changes to the Prop 65 requirements. None of the items we supply require a Prop 65 disclosure or label or warning.
